Nomad Aviation and its sister company Nomad Technics are looking back at a successful year 2018, providing aircraft management, charter and maintenance services.

Nomad Aviation has added three business jets to its aircraft management and charter services portfolio. They include a Cessna Citation CJ2+ and an Airbus ACJ319. Both aircraft are being operated under the Swiss AOC and are also available for charter. The ACJ319 proves already to be very appealing to charter customers on their worldwide flights. The third aircraft is a Bombardier CRJ100SE being flown under the Swiss NCC.

In 2018 Nomad Technics, an EASA Part-145 approved maintenance organization (Approval No. CH.145.0386), started operating at the international EuroAirport in Basel, Switzerland. The company provides maintenance inspection, non-routine repair work and AOG services on Bombardier Challenger, Global Embraer Legacy and Cessna C525 series business jets. Technical support was provided to owners of aircraft during the 2019 World Economic Forum (WEF). The company occupies its own 7'400 m² hangar together with 7'000 m² of additional ramp space. It offers also hangarage services for aircraft up to the size of the Boeing 737 series and the Airbus A320 family.
