Nomad Technics receives EASA Part-145 Line Maintenance Approval for Airbus A320 family.

Basel, March 17, 2020 Nomad Technics has received the EASA Part-145 Line Maintenance Approval for the Airbus A320 family issued by the Swiss Federal Office of Civil Aviation (FOCA).


